

# **Something about our school**

- The school year starts on 2nd September and finishes on 30th June

- At the end of each term students are given a school report
- Lessons start at 07.50 am and end at 2.00 pm
- Students are not only from Stará Ľubovňa but also from near villages and surrounding areas

### **Bilingual school**

- Graduation of the English language is at the level C1 (level state exam).
- You can submit your application either as eighth grader or classically from 9th grade of primary school.
